



Thanks to a grant from the Francophone Community Grants Program, our team worked with Dr. Julie Brown to translate the modules of the Skills system platform. The availability of this tool in French enables us to more effectively support Francophone individuals and their supports, ensuring inclusive and equitable service. This collaboration will give the international French-speaking community access to a valuable clinical tool.

This year, La Ressource wrote three grant applications and was awarded a total of \$120,000.

These grants supported:

- The translation of the Skills platform into French,
- A Train the Trainer on the Collective Impact approach by Tamarack Institute,
- A project for onboarding new employees in Valoris' residential settings.

We continue to facilitate networking and connections among Francophone professionals providing services to Francophone adults with developmental disabilities. La Ressource also supports regional initiatives in Eastern Ontario related to housing and employability for adults with developmental disabilities.
